## Clue: Big setup

Scenario: Add duplicate Job Schedule for Weekly option.

Given the following Scheduled Job exists:

```
| Process Name | Start Date | Recurrency | Time
```

| AccountingReport | 05/27/2015 | Weekly | 12:00 PM |

And user selects Start Date of '06/15/2015'

And user selects Recurrency of 'Weekly'

And user selects a time of '01:00 PM'

When user selects to Save

Then the message 'Scheduled job already exists' is displayed

## Clue: Big expectation

Scenario: User generates Payment Agency Activity Report
  Given Payment Agency '51' Begin Date '06/10/2013', and End Date '06/30/2013'
 And the user selects to run report 'Payment Agency Activity Report'
